To amend the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008 to terminate authority under the Troubled Asset Relief Program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Permanent End to
- 5 TARP Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF TARP AUTHORITY.
- 7 Section 120 of the Emergency Economic Stabilization
- 8 Act of 2008 (12 U.S.C. 5230) is amended to read as fol-
- 9 lows:

1 "SEC. 120. TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY.

- 2 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The authorities provided under
- 3 sections 101(a), excluding section 101(a)(3), and the au-
- 4 thorities provided under section 102 shall terminate on
- 5 October 3, 2010.
- 6 "(b) Treatment of Unfunded Commitments.—
- 7 With respect to a commitment to purchase made by the
- 8 Secretary under this title, including with respect to any
- 9 housing assistance pursuant to section 109 or 110, the
- 10 Secretary may not expend funds with respect to such com-
- 11 mitment on or after October 3, 2010.".
