3 SECTION 1. REPEAL OF UNEARNED INCOME MEDICARE 4 CONTRIBUTION.

Section 1402 of the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–153), and the
amendments made by such section, are hereby repealed;
and the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 shall be applied

1 as if such section, and amendments, had never been en-

2 acted.
