AN ACT

To amend section 101(a)(35) of the Immigration and Nationality Act to provide for a marriage for which the parties are not physically in the presence of each other due to service abroad in the Armed Forces of the United States.

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Marine Sergeant Mi-
- 3 chael H. Ferschke, Jr. Memorial Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. MILITARY MARRIAGES LACKING PHYSICAL PRES-
- 5 ENCE.
- 6 Section 101(a)(35) of the Immigration and Nation-
- 7 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(35)) is amended by inserting
- 8 before the period at the end "(except for failure to con-
- 9 summate the marriage caused by physical separation due
- 10 to the service abroad of one of the contracting parties in
- 11 an active-duty status in the Armed Forces of the United
- 12 States)".
- 13 SEC. 3. COMPLIANCE WITH PAYGO.
- 14 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of

- 16 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 17 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this

- 2 has been submitted prior to the vote on passage.
