AN ACT

- To provide for the approval of the Agreement Between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Australia Concerning Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1SECTION 1. APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE2GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF3AMERICA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF AUS-4TRALIA CONCERNING PEACEFUL USES OF5NUCLEAR ENERGY.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the provisions 7 for congressional consideration of a proposed agreement for cooperation in subsection d. of section 123 of the 8 9 Atomic Energy Act of 1954 (42 U.S.C. 2153), the Agreement Between the Government of the United States of 10 11 America and the Government of Australia Concerning Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy, done at New York, May 12 13 4, 2010, may become effective on or after October 8, 2010, 14 as if all the requirements in such section 123 for consideration of such agreement had been satisfied, subject to sub-15 section (b) of this section. 16

(b) APPLICABILITY OF ATOMIC ENERGY ACT OF
18 1954 AND OTHER PROVISIONS OF LAW.—Upon coming
19 into effect, the agreement referred to in subsection (a)
20 shall be subject to the provisions of the Atomic Energy
21 Act of 1954 (42 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.) and any other appli22 cable United States law as if such agreement had come

1 into effect in accordance with the requirements of section

 $2\ \ 123$ of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954.
