1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

4 This Act may be cited as the "Railroad Retirement5 Fairness Act".

6 SEC. 2. SPECIAL RULE FOR ESTABLISHING CURRENT CON-

7 NECTION RELATING TO CERTAIN EMPLOY-

MENT IN THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1(o) of the Railroad Re10 tirement Act of 1974 is amended by inserting "the De-

partment of State (in a position the Secretary of State
 certifies as railroad related)," before "the Department of
 Transportation".

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 this section applies with respect to annuities payable for
6 months beginning after the date of the enactment of this
7 Act.

8 SEC. 3. EQUITABLE EXTENSION OF CURRENT CONNECTION.

9 (a) EQUITABLE ESTOPPEL.—Section 1(o) of the Railroad Retirement Act of 1974 (45 U.S.C. 231(o)) is 10 amended by inserting "An individual who, at the time the 11 12 individual makes an inquiry to the Board, has a current connection shall not be deemed to have lost that current 13 14 connection thereafter if the Board misleads or fails to 15 properly inform that individual about that requirement and if that conduct by the Board, according to the prin-16 17 ciples of equity, should stop the Board from deeming the individual to have lost that current connection." after the 18 19 first sentence.

20 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
21 this section applies with respect to annuities applied for
22 on or after February 3, 1989.
