To authorize the transfer of a naval vessel to the Mackinac Island State Park Commission of the State of Michigan.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF TRANSFER OF NAVAL VES-

4 SEL TO THE MACKINAC ISLAND STATE PARK
5 COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN.

6 (a) TRANSFER AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of the
7 Navy shall transfer to the Mackinac Island State Park
8 Commission of the State of Michigan, all right, title, and
9 interest of the United States in an LCM–8 motorized ves10 sel for nonprofit public usage of the Mackinac Island State

Park Commission, but not for commercial purposes. The
 title to the vessel shall forever remain with the Mackinac
 Island State Park Commission of the State of Michigan.
 (b) TRANSFER ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary of the

5 Navy shall seek assistance from the Administrator of the
6 Maritime Administration to facilitate the transfer of the
7 vessel from the United States to Mackinac Island, Michi8 gan.

9 (c) DELIVERY OF VESSEL.—The Navy shall be re-10 sponsible for transporting the vessel to the Mackinac Is-11 land State Park Commission of the State of Michigan. The 12 vessel shall be donated in an "as is" condition.

13 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATION.—The Mar14 itime Administration shall cover all expenses of the trans15 fer of the vessel.

(e) ADDITIONAL TERMS.—The Secretary of the Navy
may require such additional terms and conditions in connection with the transfer under this section as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the interests of the
United States.

(f) TRANSFER DATE.—The Secretary of the Navy
shall execute the transfer described under subsection (a)
not later than 180 days after the date of enactment of
this Act.
