- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Sixth Health Insurance
- 5 Protects America—Can't Repeal IT (HIPA-CRIT) Act".

1	SEC. 2. REPEAL OF HEALTH CARE REFORM REQUIRE-
2	MENTS FOR EXTENSION OF DEPENDENT
3	ADULT CHILDREN COVERAGE.
4	The provisions of the Patient Protection and Afford-
5	able Care Act (Public Law 111–148), insofar as such Act
6	requires under section 2714(a) of the Public Health Serv-
7	ice Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg-14(a)) a group health plan and
8	a health insurance issuer offering group or individual
9	health insurance coverage that provides dependent cov-
10	erage of children to continue to make such coverage avail-
11	able for an adult child until the child turns 26 years, are
12	hereby repealed, effective as of the date of the enactment
13	of this Act.
