- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Third Health Insur-
- 5 ance Protects America—Can't Repeal IT (HIPA-CRIT)
- 6 Act".

2	ON ESTABLISHMENT OF LIFETIME LIMITS ON

4	The provisions of the Patient Protection and Afford-
5	able Care Act (Public Law 111–148), insofar as such Act
6	under section 2711(a)(1)(A) of the Public Health Service
7	Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg-11(a)(1)(A)) prohibits a group
8	health plan or a health insurance issuer offering group or
9	individual health insurance coverage from establishing life-
10	time limits on the dollar value of benefits for any partici-
11	pant or beneficiary, are hereby repealed, effective as of
12	the date of the enactment of this Act.
