## A BILL

To require reports on the management of Arlington National Cemetery.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REPORTS ON MANAGEMENT OF ARLINGTON
- 4 NATIONAL CEMETERY.
- 5 (a) Report on Gravesite Discrepancies.—Not
- 6 later than one year after the date of the enactment of this
- 7 Act, the Secretary of the Army shall submit to the com-
- 8 mittees of Congress specified in subsection (c) a report
- 9 setting forth an accounting of the gravesites at Arlington
- 10 National Cemetery, Virginia. The accounting shall—

1	(1) specify whether gravesite locations at Ar-
2	lington National Cemetery are correctly identified,
3	labeled, and occupied; and
4	(2) set forth a plan of action, including the re-
5	sources required and a proposed schedule, to imple-
6	ment remedial actions to address deficiencies identi-
7	fied pursuant to the accounting.
8	(b) GAO REVIEW OF MANAGEMENT AND OVERSIGHT
9	of Contracts.—
10	(1) In general.—Not later than one year
11	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
12	Comptroller General of the United States shall sub-
13	mit to the committees of Congress specified in sub-
14	section (c) a report on the management and over-
15	sight of contracts at Arlington National Cemetery.
16	(2) Elements.—The report required by para-
17	graph (1) shall include the following:
18	(A) The number, dollar amount, and dura-
19	tion of current contracts at Arlington National
20	Cemetery over the simplified acquisition thresh-
21	old.
22	(B) The number, dollar amount, and dura-
23	tion of current contracts for automation of bur-
24	ial operations at Arlington National Cemetery,
25	including contracts relating to the Total Ceme-

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tery Management System (TCMS), the Geographic Information System (GIS), the Interment Scheduling System (ISS), the Interment Management System (IMS), and new or modified versions of the Burial Operations Support System (BOSS) of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

- (C) An assessment of the management and oversight by the Executive Director of the Army National Cemeteries Program of the contracts covered by subparagraphs (A) and (B), including the use of and actions taken for that purpose by the Corps of Engineers and the National Capital Region Contracting Center of the Army Contracting Command.
- (D) An assessment of the actions taken by the Executive Director of the Army National Cemeteries Program in response to the findings and recommendations of the Inspector General of the Army in the report entitled "Report of Investigation and Special Inspection of Arlington National Cemetery Final Report (Case 10– 04)", dated June 9, 2010.
- (E) An assessment of the implementation of the following:

- (F) An assessment of the adequacy of current practices at Arlington National Cemetery to provide information, outreach, and support to families of individuals buried at Arlington National Cemetery regarding procedures to detect and correct current errors in burials at Arlington National Cemetery.

- 1 (G) An assessment of the feasibility and 2 advisability of transferring jurisdiction of Arlington National Cemetery and the United 3 4 States Soldiers' and Airmen's Home National Cemetery to the Department of Veterans Af-6 fairs, and an assessment of the feasibility and 7 advisability of the sharing of jurisdiction of 8 such facilities between the Department of De-9 fense and the Department of Veterans Affairs. 10 (3) SIMPLIFIED ACQUISITION THRESHOLD DE-11 FINED.—In this subsection, the term "simplified ac-12 quisition threshold" has the meaning provided that 13 term in section 4 of the Office of Federal Procure-

- (d) Reports on Implementation of Army Directive on Army National Cemeteries Program.—
- (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army shall submit to the appropriate committees of Con-gress reports on execution of and compliance with Army Directive 2010–04 on Enhancing the Oper-ations and Oversight of the Army National Ceme-teries Program, dated June 10, 2010. Each such re-port shall include, for the preceding 270 days or year (as applicable), a description and assessment of the following:
  - (A) Execution of and compliance with every section of the Army Directive for Arlington National Cemetery, including, without limitation, an evaluation of the sufficiency of all contract management and oversight procedures, current and planned information and technology systems, applications, and contracts, current organizational structure and manpower, and compliance with and execution of all plans, reviews, studies, evaluations, and requirements specified in the Army Directive.
  - (B) The adequacy of current practices at Arlington National Cemetery to provide information, outreach, and support to families of

5	(2) Period and frequency of submittal.—

(2) Period and frequency of submittal.— A report required by paragraph (1) shall be submitted not later than 270 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, and every year thereafter for the next 2 years.

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
