1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Georges Bank Preser-3 vation Act".

4 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON LEASING IN CERTAIN FEDERAL 5 PROTECTED AREAS.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi7 sion of Federal law, no lease or other authorization may
8 be issued by the Federal Government that authorizes ex9 ploration, development, or production of oil or natural gas
10 in—

(1) any marine national monument or nationalmarine sanctuary; or

(2) the fishing grounds known as Georges Bank
in the waters of the United States, which is one of
the largest and historically important fishing
grounds of the United States.

(b) IDENTIFICATION OF COORDINATES OF GEORGES
BANK.—The Secretary of Commerce, after publication of
public notice and an opportunity for public comment, shall
identify the specific coordinates that delineate Georges
Bank in the waters of the United States for purposes of
subsection (a).
