Mr. FILNER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

For the relief of Francisco Rivera and Alfonso Calderon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. COMPENSATION OF FRANCISCO RIVERA AND**
4 **ALFONSO CALDERON.**

5 (a) PAYMENT.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall
6 pay, out of funds not otherwise appropriated, an appro-
7 priate amount to compensate Francisco Rivera and Al-
8 fonso Calderon for costs related to and damages arising
9 from their arrest, prosecution, and incarceration in Mexico
10 as described in Claim No. 05–608C filed in the United
11 States Court of Federal Claims.

1 (b) SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS.—The payment under
2 subsection (a) shall be in full satisfaction of all claims of
3 Francisco Rivera and Alfonso Calderon against the United
4 States in connection with the matter described in such
5 subsection.

6 (c) NO INFERENCE OF LIABILITY.—Nothing in this
7 Act shall be construed as an inference of liability on the
8 part of the United States.

9 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEYS' AND AGENTS' FEES.**

10 (a) IN GENERAL.—It shall be unlawful for an amount
11 exceeding 10 percent of the amount paid pursuant to sec-
12 tion 1 to be paid to, or received by, any agent or attorney
13 for any service rendered in connection with the payment
14 under this Act.

15 (b) ENFORCEMENT.—Any person who violates sub-
16 section (a) shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be
17 fined under title 18, United States Code.

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
