5	None of the funds appropriated or otherwise made
6	available to any Federal department or agency may be

8	(1) transfer any enemy combatant detained by
9	the United States at Naval Station, Guantanamo
10	Bay, Cuba, to any military or prison installation lo-
11	cated in the State of Arizona; or
12	(2) build, modify, or enhance any facility in the
13	State of Arizona for the purpose of housing any
14	such enemy combatant.
