## AN ACT

To increase Federal Pell Grants for the children of fallen public safety officers, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

| 2  | This Act may be cited as the "Officer Daniel Faulk-     |
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| 3  | ner Children of Fallen Heroes Scholarship Act of 2010". |
| 4  | SEC. 2. CALCULATION OF ELIGIBILITY.                     |
| 5  | Section 473(b) of the Higher Education Act of 1965      |
| 6  | (20 U.S.C. 1087mm(b)) is amended—                       |
| 7  | (1) in paragraph (2)—                                   |
| 8  | (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph                |
| 9  | (A), by inserting "(in the case of a student who        |
| 10 | meets the requirement of subparagraph (B)(i)),          |
| 11 | or academic year 2011–2012 (in the case of a            |
| 12 | student who meets the requirement of subpara-           |
| 13 | graph (B)(ii))," after "academic year 2009–             |
| 14 | 2010"; and  |
| 15 | (B) by amending subparagraph (B) to read                |
| 16 | as follows:   |

| 11 | an individual serving a public agency in an offi-     |
| 12 | cial capacity, with or without compensation, as       |
| 13 | a law enforcement officer, as a firefighter, or as    |
| 14 | a member of a rescue squad or ambulance crew;         |
| 15 | "(B) the term 'law enforcement officer'               |
| 16 | means an individual who—                              |
| 17 | "(i) is authorized by law to engage in                |
| 18 | or supervise the prevention, detection, in-           |
| 19 | vestigation, or prosecution of, or the incar-         |
| 20 | ceration of any person for, any violation of          |
| 21 | law; and  |
| 22 | "(ii) has statutory powers of arrest or               |
| 23 | apprehension;   |
| 24 | "(C) the term 'firefighter' means an indi-            |
| 25 | vidual who is trained in the suppression of fire      |

or hazardous-materials response and has the legal authority to engage in these duties;

"(D) the term 'member of a rescue squad or ambulance crew' means an individual who is an officially recognized or designated public employee member of a rescue squad or ambulance crew; and

"(E) the term 'public agency' means the United States, any State of the United States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands of the United States, Guam, American Samoa, the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, any territory or possession of the United States, or any unit of local government, department, agency, or instrumentality of any of the foregoing, and the Amtrak Police and Federal Reserve Police departments.".

#### 20 SEC. 3. CALCULATION OF PELL GRANT AMOUNT.

- 21 Section 401(b)(2) of the Higher Education Act of
- 22 1965, as amended by the SAFRA Act (Public Law 111–
- 23 152), is amended—

- Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record 8
- by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
- vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
- 11 vote on passage.
- 12 SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 13 This Act, and the amendments made by this Act,
- shall take effect on July 1, 2011. 14
