- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROTECTION FOR PASSENGERS OF FOREIGN
- 4 AIR TRANSPORTATION.
- 5 When the Secretary of Transportation issues a rule
- 6 enhancing airline passenger protection by requiring airline
- 7 emergency contingency plans, the Secretary shall include
- 8 in such a rule a requirement that the owner or operator
- 9 of an airport, including a reliever airport, that serves air
- 10 carriers and foreign air carriers shall coordinate with the

- 1 United States Customs and Border Protection to ensure
- 2 that adequate resources and personnel are available to
- 3 process passengers arriving into or departing from the

4 United States in the event of a tarmac delay.
