RESOLUTION

Establishing a Select Committee on POW and MIA Affairs.

- 1 Resolved, That there is established in the House of
- 2 Representatives a select committee to be known as the Se-
- 3 lect Committee on POW and MIA Affairs.

1	FUNCTIONS
2	Sec. 2. The select committee shall conduct a full in-
3	vestigation of all unresolved matters relating to any
4	United States personnel unaccounted for from the Viet-
5	nam era, the Korean conflict, World War II, Cold War
6	Missions, Persian Gulf War, Operation Iraqi Freedom, or
7	Operation Enduring Freedom, including MIA's and
8	POW's missing and captured.
9	APPOINTMENT AND MEMBERSHIP
10	Sec. 3. (a) Members.—The select committee shall
11	be composed of 10 Members of the House, who shall be
12	appointed by the Speaker. Not more than half of the mem-
13	bers of the select committee shall be of the same political
14	party.
15	(b) Vacancy.—Any vacancy occurring in the mem-
16	bership of the select committee shall be filled in the same
17	manner in which the original appointment was made.
18	(c) Chairperson.—The Speaker shall designate one
19	member of the select committee to be its chairperson.
20	AUTHORITY AND PROCEDURES
21	Sec. 4. (a) Authority.—For purposes of carrying
22	out this resolution, the select committee (or any sub-
23	committee of the select committee authorized to hold hear-
24	ings) may sit and act during the present Congress at any
25	time or place within the United States (including any
26	Commonwealth or possession of the United States, or else-

- 1 where, whether the House is in session, has recessed, or
- 2 has adjourned) and to hold such hearings as it considers
- 3 necessary.
- 4 (b) Rules of Procedure.—The provisions of
- 5 clauses 1, 2, and 4 of rule XI of the Rules of the House
- 6 shall apply to the select committee.
- 7 (c) Prohibition Against Meeting at Certain
- 8 Times.—Subsection (a) may not be construed to limit the
- 9 applicability of clause 2(i) of rule XI of the Rules of the
- 10 House to the select committee.
- 11 ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS
- SEC. 5. (a) EXPENSES.—Subject to the adoption of
- 13 expense resolutions as required by clause 6 of rule X of
- 14 the Rules of the House, the select committee may incur
- 15 expenses in connection with its functions under this reso-
- 16 lution.
- 17 (b) Staff and Travel.—In carrying out its func-
- 18 tions under this resolution, the select committee may—
- 19 (1) appoint, either on a permanent basis or as
- 20 experts or consultants, any staff that the select com-
- 21 mittee considers necessary;
- 22 (2) prescribe the duties and responsibilities of
- 23 the staff;
- (3) fix the compensation of the staff at a single
- per annum gross rate that does not exceed the high-
- est rate of basic pay, as in effect from time to time,

- of level V of the Executive Schedule in section 5316 of title 5, United States Code;
 - (4) terminate the employment of any such staff as the select committee considers appropriate; and
- 5 (5) reimburse members of the select committee 6 and of its staff for travel, subsistence, and other 7 necessary expenses incurred by them in the perform-8 ance of their functions for the select committee, 9 other than expenses in connection with any meeting 10 of the select committee, or a subcommittee thereof, 11 held in the District of Columbia.
- 12 (c) EXPIRATION.—The select committee and all au-13 thority granted in this resolution shall expire 30 days after 14 the filing of the final report of the select committee with
- 16 REPORTS AND RECORDS
- 17 Sec. 6. (a) Final Report.—As soon as practicable
- 18 during the present Congress, the select committee shall
- 19 submit to the House a final report setting forth its find-
- 20 ings and recommendations as a result of its investigation.
- 21 (b) FILING OF REPORTS.—Any report made by the
- 22 select committee when the House is not in session shall
- 23 be filed with the Clerk of the House.
- (c) Referral of Reports.—Any report made by
- 25 the select committee shall be referred to the committee

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the House.

or committees that have jurisdiction over the subject matter of the report. 3 (d) Records, Files, and Materials.—Following the termination of the select committee, the records, files, 5 and materials of the select committee shall be transferred to the Clerk of the House. If the final report of the select committee is referred to only one committee under the 8 provisions of subsection (c), the records, files, and materials of the select committee shall be transferred instead 10 to the committee to which the final report is referred. 11 **DEFINITIONS** 12 Sec. 7. For purposes of this resolution: (1) The term "Member of the House" means 13 14 any Representative in, or Delegate or Resident Com-15 missioner to, the Congress. (2) The term "MIA" means any United States 16 17 personnel that is unaccounted for and missing in ac-18 tion. (3) The term "POW" means any United States 19 20 personnel that is unaccounted for and known to be 21 a prisoner of war. 22 (4) The term "select committee" means the Se-23 lect Committee on MIA and POW Affairs estab-

lished by this resolution.

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
