- 5 "11. (a) Any bill, joint resolution, amendment, or

- 7 propriation as an emergency requirement may not be con-
- 8 sidered as passed or agreed to unless so determined by

- 1 a vote of not less than three-fifths of the Members voting,
- 2 a quorum being present.
- 3 "(b) Paragraph (a) shall not apply to spending for
- 4 the Department of Defense or any spending from a des-

5 ignated emergency fund.".
