RESOLUTION

Expressing support for designation of July 17, 2010, as "National Bladder Cancer Awareness Day".

- Whereas it is estimated that nearly 71,000 new cases of bladder cancer were diagnosed in 2009;
- Whereas bladder cancer has the highest recurrence rate of any form of cancer;
- Whereas bladder cancer is nearly three times more likely to occur in men than in women and is the fourth most common cancer diagnosed in men;
- Whereas nearly 90 percent of people with bladder cancer are over the age of 55;
- Whereas it is estimated that over 14,000 people in the United States died from bladder cancer in 2009; and

Whereas July 17, 2010, would be an appropriate date to designate as "National Bladder Cancer Awareness Day": Now, therefore, be it
