RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require that Members official websites include congressional earmark requests and video presentations for requests submitted to committees.

- 1 Resolved, That clause 17 of rule XXIII of the Rules
- 2 of the House of Representatives is amended by adding at
- 3 the end the following new paragraph:
- 4 "(c) (1) Each Member, Delegate, or Resident Com-
- 5 missioner shall maintain an official website and include
- 6 on it a comprehensive, sortable, and searchable database
- 7 comprised of all congressional earmark request for the
- 8 current fiscal year, and for the budget year including for

- 1 each such request the name and address of any recipient,
- 2 the purpose of the earmark, the merits of the earmark,
- 3 whether it meets applicable eligibility requirements (if
- 4 any), the amount requested, and, in the case of the Com-
- 5 mittee on Appropriations, a video presentation by the in-
- 6 tended recipient with a link for public comment.
- 7 "(2) Each Member, Delegate, or Resident Commis-
- 8 sioner may waive the requirement for a video presentation
- 9 by the intended recipient of a congressional earmark if the
- 10 Member, Delegate, or Resident Commissioner determines
- 11 that the video presentation is unnecessary and places that
- 12 determination on the official website of that Member, Del-
- 13 egate, or Resident Commissioner.".
