- Whereas, on September 27, 2010, the Dow Chemical Company will fly 75 Texas World War II veterans who retired from the company to Washington, DC, as part of the Honor Flight program;

Whereas the visit will allow the veterans to visit the memorials built in their honor and pay tribute to those with whom they served in the Armed Forces, as well as to those who followed in their footsteps; and
