RESOLUTION

Expressing support for designation of the month of October as Italian and Italian American Heritage Month.

Whereas Italian and Italian American Heritage Month recognizes the enormous contributions the Italian and Italian American people have made to the United States and the world throughout history, including generals, admirals, philosophers, statesmen, musicians, athletes, and Nobel Prize-winning scientists;

Whereas Italian and Italian American Heritage Month salutes the Italian and Italian American community and expresses appreciation for their culture and heritage that have immeasurably enriched the lives of the people of the United States and the world;

Whereas the strength and success of the United States, the vitality of its communities, and the effectiveness of its society depend, in great measure, upon the distinctive and sterling qualities demonstrated by various ethnic groups, exemplified by members of the Italian and Italian American community, who share with their rich and unique heritage; and

Whereas the month of October would be an appropriate month to designate as Italian and Italian American Heritage Month: Now, therefore, be it
