provided to WikiLeaks and select public press outlets, as

referenced in the November 27, 2010, letter by the De partment of State Legal Adviser, Harold Hongju Koh, to
Ms. Jennifer Robinson, attorney for Mr. Julian Assange,
which notes the approximately 250,000 documents that
have been provided to select press outlets by WikiLeaks.
