RESOLUTION

Of inquiry requesting the President and directing the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency and the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to provide certain documents to the House of Representatives relating to the Environmental Protection Agency's April proposed finding that greenhouse gas emissions are a danger to public health and welfare.

1 *Resolved*, That the President is requested and the Ad-
2 ministrators of the Environmental Protection Agency and
3 the Director of the Office of Management and Budget are
4 directed to furnish the House of Representatives, not later

1 than 14 days after the adoption of this resolution, all doc-
2 uments, including telephone and electronic mail records,
3 logs and calendars, and records of internal discussions in
4 the possession of the Administrator of the Environmental
5 Protection Agency or the Director of the Office of Man-
6 agement and Budget, relating to the following:

7 (1) The untitled, undated memo marked “De-
8 liberative—Attorney Client Privilege”, which begins
9 “The NPRM fails to articulate the process by which
10 the Administrator came to the conclusion on p. 30”.

11 (2) Interagency comments or documents related
12 to the Environmental Protection Agency’s April pro-
13 posed finding that greenhouse gas emissions are a
14 danger to public health and welfare.

15 (3) Cost benefit or systematic risk analysis re-
16 lated to the Environmental Protection Agency’s
17 April proposed finding that greenhouse gas emis-
18 sions are a danger to public health and welfare.

19 (4) Scientific evidence or opinion that dem-
20 onstrates health effects of greenhouse gases.
