- 1 Resolved, That (a) clause 9 of rule XXI of the Rules
- 2 of the House of Representatives is amended by adding the
- 3 following new paragraph:
- 4 "(h) It shall not be in order to consider any bill, joint
- 5 resolution, amendment, or conference report if that meas-
- 6 ure or any accompanying report or joint explanatory state-
- 7 ment of managers contains a congressional earmark for
- 8 an organization other than an organization which is ex-
- 9 empt from the tax imposed under chapter 1 of the Internal
- 10 Revenue Code of 1986 or a governmental entity.".

- 1 (b) The amendment made by subsection (a) shall only
- 2 be applicable if the underlying bill or joint resolution is
- 3 reported after the date of adoption of this resolution or
- 4 considered pursuant to a special order of business agreed

5 to after the date of adoption of this resolution.
