6 January 20, 2009, that refers or relates to any rec-
7 ommendation regarding medical malpractice reform;
8 or

9 (2) that references the American Association
10 for Justice, formerly known as the Association of
11 Trial Lawyers of America, or any of its members,
12 and refers or relates to any recommendation regard-
13 ing medical malpractice reform, since January 20,
14 2009.
