- 1 Resolved, That clause 5 of rule XXI of the Rules of
- 2 the House of Representatives is amended by adding at the
- 3 end the following:
- 4 "(d) It shall not be in order to consider a bill, joint
- 5 resolution, amendment, or conference report carrying an
- 6 increase in the amount of tax imposed on individuals
- 7 under chapter 1 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986
- 8 if such tax is determined by reference (directly or indi-
- 9 rectly) to the gross income of the taxpayer and the imposi-

- 1 tion of the tax is based solely on the taxpayer's violation
- 2 of a condition.".
