Mr. Hastings of Florida submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

RESOLUTION

Expressing sympathy for and solidarity with the people of the Russian Federation following the bombing of the Nevsky Express.

- Whereas on the night of November 27, 2009, a bomb exploded on the railroad tracks derailing the Nevsky Express, a passenger train traveling from Moscow to St. Petersburg, Russia;
- Whereas more than 25 people were killed and scores more wounded in this terrorist attack;
- Whereas the attack on the Nevsky Express was the worst terrorist attack in Russia in years, outside the volatile North Caucasus;
- Whereas such acts of violence against civilian targets are clearly intended to spread fear across all levels of society

and thus injure, at least psychologically, a far greater number of people than those physically present at the scene of the attack; and

Whereas the United States and many other nations have also experienced such acts of terrorism: Now, therefore, be it
