3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Bay Area Regional
- 5 Water Recycling Program Expansion Act of 2009".

6 SEC. 2. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and
8 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (43 U.S.C. 390h
9 et seq.) (as amended by section 512(a) of the Consolidated

Natural Resources Act of 2008) is amended by adding at
 the end the following:

3 "SEC. 1649. CCCSD-CONCORD RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.

4 "(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera5 tion with the Central Contra Costa Sanitary District, Cali6 fornia, is authorized to participate in the design, planning,
7 and construction of recycled water distribution systems.
8 "(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
9 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed
10 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

11 "(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide
12 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project
13 authorized by this section.

14 "(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
15 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
16 \$1,800,000.

17 "SEC. 1650. CENTRAL DUBLIN RECYCLED WATER DISTRIBU-

18

TION AND RETROFIT PROJECT.

"(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in cooperation with the Dublin San Ramon Services District, California, is authorized to participate in the design, planning,
and construction of recycled water system facilities.

23 "(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
24 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed
25 percent of the total cost of the project.

"(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide
 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project
 authorized by this section.

4 "(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
5 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
6 \$1,150,000.

7 "SEC. 1651. PETALUMA RECYCLED WATER PROJECT, 8 PHASES 2A, 2B, AND 3.

9 "(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-10 tion with the City of Petaluma, California, is authorized 11 to participate in the design, planning, and construction of 12 recycled water system facilities.

13 "(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
14 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed
15 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

16 "(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide
17 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project
18 authorized by this section.

19 "(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
20 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
21 \$6,000,000.

22 "SEC. 1652. CENTRAL REDWOOD CITY RECYCLED WATER 23 PROJECT.

24 "(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-25 tion with the City of Redwood City, California, is author-

ized to participate in the design, planning, and construc tion of recycled water system facilities.

3 "(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
4 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed
5 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

6 "(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide
7 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project
8 authorized by this section.

9 "(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
10 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
11 \$8,000,000.

12 "SEC. 1653. PALO ALTO RECYCLED WATER PIPELINE 13 PROJECT.

14 "(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera15 tion with the City of Palo Alto, California, is authorized
16 to participate in the design, planning, and construction of
17 recycled water system facilities.

18 "(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
19 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed
20 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

21 "(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide
22 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project
23 authorized by this section.

"(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
 \$8,250,000.

4 "SEC. 1654. IRONHOUSE SANITARY DISTRICT (ISD) ANTIOCH 5 RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.

6 "(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera7 tion with the Ironhouse Sanitary District (ISD), Cali8 fornia, is authorized to participate in the design, planning,
9 and construction of recycled water distribution systems.
10 "(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
11 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed
12 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

13 "(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide
14 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project
15 authorized by this section.

16 "(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
17 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
18 \$7,000,000.".

(b) PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION.—In carrying out
sections 1642 through 1648 of the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act, and sections 1649 through 1654 of such Act, as added by subsection (a), the Secretary shall enter into individual agreements with the San Francisco Bay Area Regional Water
Recycling implementing agencies to fund the projects

through the Bay Area Clean Water Agencies (BACWA)
 or its successor, and shall include in such agreements a
 provision for the reimbursement of construction costs, in cluding those construction costs incurred prior to the en actment of this Act.

6 (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—The table of contents 7 of the Reclamation Projects Authorization and Adjust-8 ment Act of 1992 (43 U.S.C. prec. 371) (as amended by 9 section 512(a) of the Consolidated Natural Resources Act 10 of 2008) is amended by inserting after the item relating 11 to section 1648 the following new items:

"Sec. 1649. CCCSD-Concord recycled water project.
"Sec. 1650. Central Dublin recycled water distribution and retrofit project.
"Sec. 1651. Petaluma recycled water project, phases 2a, 2b, and 3.
"Sec. 1652. Central Redwood City recycled water project.
"Sec. 1653. Palo Alto recycled water pipeline project.
"Sec. 1654. Ironhouse Sanitary District (ISD) Antioch recycled water project.".
