To require notification of the Federal Aviation Administration with respect to wildlife strikes, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Wildlife Strike Act
- 5 of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT WITH RESPECT TO
- 7 WILDLIFE STRIKES ON AIRCRAFT.
- 8 (a) In General.—Chapter 447 of title 49, United
- 9 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 10 lowing:

1 "§ 44730. Notification of wildlife strikes

2	"The Administrator of the Federal Aviation Adminis-
3	tration shall be notified, by the most expeditious means
4	available—
5	"(1) by the operator of a civil aircraft or a pub-
6	lic aircraft (other than a public aircraft operated by
7	the armed forces or by an intelligence agency of the
8	United States), if the aircraft collides with 1 or
9	more birds or other wildlife;
10	"(2) by airport personnel or personnel of the
11	operator of an aircraft described in paragraph (1),
12	if such personnel see such a collision; and
13	"(3) by aircraft maintenance personnel, if such
14	personnel identify damage to an aircraft resulting
15	from such a collision.".

17	tions for chapter 447 of title 49, United States Code, is
