- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENDING THE LENGTH OF FLIGHTS FROM
- 4 RONALD REAGAN WASHINGTON NATIONAL
- 5 AIRPORT.
- 6 Section 41718 of title 49, United States Code, is
- 7 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 8 "(g) Use of Airport Slots for Beyond Perim-
- 9 ETER FLIGHTS.—Notwithstanding section 49109 or any

- 1 other provision of law, any air carrier that holds or oper-
- 2 ates air carrier slots at Ronald Reagan Washington Na-
- 3 tional Airport as of January 1, 2009, pursuant to subparts
- 4 K and S of part 93 of title 14, Code of Federal Regula-
- 5 tions, which are being used as of that date for scheduled
- 6 service between that airport and a large hub airport (as
- 7 defined in section 40102(a)(29)), may use such slots for
- 8 service between Ronald Reagan Washington National Air-
- 9 port and any airport located outside of the perimeter re-
- 10 striction described in section 49109.".
