To clarify the definition of switchblade knives.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3	SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF SWITCHBLADE KNIVES.
4	(a) In General.—Section 4 of the Act entitled "An
5	Act to prohibit the introduction, or manufacture for intro-
6	duction, into interstate commerce of switchblade knives,
7	and for other purposes" (commonly known as the Federal
8	Switchblade Act) (15 U.S.C. 1244) is amended—
9	(1) by striking "or" at the end of paragraph

- "(5) a knife that contains a spring, detent, or other mechanism designed to create a bias toward closure of the blade and that requires exertion applied to the blade by hand, wrist, or arm to overcome the bias toward closure to assist in opening the knife.".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by 9 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-10 ment of this Act.
