- 3 SECTION 1. TAX-EXEMPT BOND FINANCING FOR FIXED-
- 4 WING EMERGENCY MEDICAL AIRCRAFT.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (e) of section 147 of
- 6 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to no portion
- 7 of bonds may be issued for skyboxes, airplanes, gambling
- 8 establishments, etc.) is amended by adding at the end the
- 9 following new sentence: "The preceding sentence shall not
- 10 apply to any fixed-wing aircraft equipped for, and exclu-

- 1 sively dedicated to providing, acute care emergency med-
- 2 ical services (within the meaning of 4261(g)(2))."
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 this section shall apply to obligations issued after the date

5 of the enactment of this Act.
