- 6 PROPERTY.
- 7 (a) In General.—Paragraph (4) of section 25C(c)
- 8 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by strik-
- 9 ing "is equal to" and all that follows and inserting "meets

- 1 the criteria for such components established by the 2010
- 2 Energy Star Program Requirements for Residential Win-
- 3 dows, Doors, and Skylights, Version 5.0 (or any subse-
- 4 quent version of such requirements which is in effect after
- 5 January 4, 2010).".
- 6 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 7 this section shall apply to property placed in service after
- 8 December 31, 2009.
