## A BILL

To reinstate Federal matching of State spending of child support incentive payments.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Child Support Protec-  
5       tion Act of 2009”.

6       **SEC. 2. REINSTATEMENT OF FEDERAL MATCHING OF**  
7                       **STATE SPENDING OF CHILD SUPPORT INCEN-**  
8                       **TIVE PAYMENTS.**

9       Effective October 1, 2010, section 455(a)(1) of the  
10      Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 655(a)(1)) is amended by

1 striking “from amounts paid to the State under section  
2 458 or”.
