A BILL

To extend the temporary duty suspension on certain pepperoncini prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN PEPPERONCINI PREPARED OR PRE-**
4 **SERVED OTHERWISE THAN BY VINEGAR.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.10.27 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 pepperoncini prepared or preserved otherwise than by vin-
8 egar, not frozen) is amended by striking the date in the
9 effective period column and inserting “12/31/2011”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
