2 "12/31/2011"; and
3 (2) by striking "free" and inserting "1%".
4 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
6 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
7 the date of the enactment of this Act.
