A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on grocery bags with an exterior surface of nonwoven fabric wholly of polypropylene.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GROCERY BAGS WITH AN EXTERIOR SURFACE**
4 **OF NONWOVEN FABRIC WHOLLY OF POLY-**
5 **PROPYLENE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Grocery bags with an exterior surface of nonwoven fabric wholly of polypropylene, of which the fabric comprising the outer surface of the bag is at least 70 grams per square meter and does not exceed 110 grams per square meter, with a foam insulation lining, with handles of nonwoven fabric wholly of polypropylene sewn on, with a capacity not to exceed 23 liters each, of a type used to carry food or beverages purchased in grocery stores, supermarkets or pharmacies or the like (provided for in sub-heading 4202.92.08)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
