## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on ultra-high molecular weight polyethylene yarn measuring not less than 341 decitex but not more than 510 decitex.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ULTRA-HIGH MOLECULAR WEIGHT POLY-**  
4                       **ETHYLENE YARN MEASURING NOT LESS**  
5                       **THAN 341 DECITEX BUT NOT MORE THAN 510**  
6                       **DECITEX.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
8       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
9       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
10      new heading:

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
