1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3** SECTION 1. CERTAIN RAYON STAPLE FIBERS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.55.04 of the Har5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend6 ed—

7 (1) in the article description, by striking "fila8 ments" and inserting "staple fibers";

9 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
10 column and inserting "12/31/2011"; and

(3) by striking "Free" in the column 1 general
 rate of duty column and inserting "1.8%".

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
4 this section apply with respect to goods entered, or with5 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
6 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
