To extend the temporary suspension of duty on ion exchange
resin powder.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ION EXCHANGE RESIN POWDER.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.11.78 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 ion exchange resin powder) is amended by striking “12/
7 31/2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
