## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on Ipeconazole.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IPCONAZOLE (2-[(4-CHLOROPHENYL)METHYL]-5-**  
4 **(1-METHYLETHYL)-1-(1H-1,2,4-TRIAZOL-1-**  
5 **YLMETHYL) CYCLOPENTANOL).**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.25.08 of the Har-  
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
8 Ipeconazole) is amended by striking the date in the effec-  
9 tive period column and inserting “12/31/2011”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
11 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
