- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 9902.11.90 of the
- 7 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating
- 8 to certain cases or containers to be used for electronic

- 1 drawing toys, electronic games, or educational toys) is
- 2 amended—
- 3 (1) in the article description, by inserting after
- 4 "or 9504" and inserting ", or educational toys or
- 5 devices of heading 8543"; and
- 6 (2) in the effective period column, by striking
- 7 "12/31/2009" and inserting "12/31/2011".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 9 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
