- 7 date in the effective column period and inserting "12/31/
- 8 2011".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
