A BILL

To reduce temporarily the duty on parts of microwave ovens
for the industrial preparation or manufacture of dried

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PARTS OF MICROWAVE OVENS FOR THE INDUS-**
2 **TRIAL PREPARATION OR MANUFACTURE OF**
3 **DRIED VEGETABLE SNACK (SMALL PORTIONS**
4 **OF FOOD USUALLY EATEN OTHER THAN AT**
5 **MEAL TIMES) ITEMS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Parts of microwave ovens for the industrial preparation or manufacture of dried vegetable snack (small portions of food usually eaten other than at meal times) items (provided for in subheading 8514.90.40)	2.0%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.
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10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
12 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
13 the date of the enactment of this Act.
