A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain leather upper footwear.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN LEATHER UPPER FOOTWEAR.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Other footwear with outer soles of rubber, plastic, leather, or composition leather and uppers of leather, not covering the ankle, valued at more than \$2.50 per pair, other than house slippers, tennis shoes, basketball shoes, and the like, the foregoing for persons other than women (provided for in subheading 6403.99.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
