A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain entries of manufacturing equipment entered on or after May 11, 1997, and before October 21, 1998.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

 SECTION 1. LIQUIDATION OR RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN

 MANUFACTURING EQUIPMENT ENTERED ON

 OR AFTER MAY 11, 1997, AND BEFORE OCTOBER 21, 1998.

 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 514 and
- 8 520 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514 and 1520)
- 9 or any other provision of law, not later than 90 days after

1	the receipt of the request described in subsection (b), any
2	article—
3	(1) that was entered, or withdrawn from ware-
4	house for consumption—
5	(A) on or after May 11, 1997; and
6	(B) before October 21, 1998; and
7	(2) with respect to which heading 9902.84.89 of
8	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
9	States would have applied if such article had been
10	entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consump-
11	tion, on December 31, 2001,
12	shall be liquidated or reliquidated as if such heading
13	9902.84.89 applied to such entry or withdrawal, and U.S.
14	Customs and Border Protection shall refund any excess
15	duty paid with respect to such entry.
16	(b) Requests.—Liquidation or reliquidation may be
17	made under subsection (a) with respect to any entry only
18	if a request therefor is filed with U.S. Customs and Bor-
19	der Protection, not later than 180 days after the date of
20	the enactment of this Act, that contains sufficient infor-
21	mation to enable U.S. Customs and Border Protection—
22	(1) to locate the entry; or
23	(2) to reconstruct the entry if it cannot be lo-
24	cated.
