Mr. GRAHAM introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain manufacturing equipment.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN MANUFACTURING EQUIPMENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.84.85 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 certain manufacturing equipment) is amended—

7 (1) by amending the article description to read
8 as follows: “Extruders to be used in production of
9 radial tires designed for off-the-highway use with a
10 rim measuring 63.5 cm or more in diameter (such

1 tires provided for in subheading 4011.20.10,
2 4011.61.00, 4011.63.00, 4011.69.00, 4011.92.00,
3 4011.94.40, or 4011.99.45), numerically controlled,
4 or parts thereof (provided for in subheading
5 8477.20.00 or 8477.90.85)”; and

6 (2) by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting
7 “12/31/2011”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
11 the date of enactment of this Act.
