To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain manufacturing equipment.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN MANUFACTURING EQUIPMENT. 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.84.85 of the Har-5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to certain manufacturing equipment) is amended— 6 7 (1) by amending the article description to read 8 as follows: "Extruders to be used in production of 9 radial tires designed for off-the-highway use with a

rim measuring 63.5 cm or more in diameter (such

- 1 tires provided for in subheading 4011.20.10,
- 2 4011.61.00, 4011.63.00, 4011.69.00, 4011.92.00,
- 3 4011.94.40, or 4011.99.45), numerically controlled,
- 4 or parts thereof (provided for in subheading
- 5 8477.20.00 or 8477.90.85)"; and
- 6 (2) by striking "12/31/2009" and inserting
- 7 "12/31/2011".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 9 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 11 the date of enactment of this Act.
