A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain electric cooktops.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ELECTRIC COOKTOPS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Electric cooktops each measuring approximately 66 cm or more but not over 91.44 cm in width, weighing approximately 10.3 kg or more but not more than 20.9 kg, having either a coil electric cooking element or smooth cooking surface with incorporated element with either 4 or 5 burners (provided for in subheading 8516.60.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
