8	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
9	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
10	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following

	" 9902.01.00 Men's wading boots, valued over \$30/pair, with textile outer soles and uppers of leather or composition leather whose height from the bottom of the outer sole to the top of the upper does not exceed 9 inches (22.86 cm) (provided for in subheading 6405.20.90)

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by 13 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from 14 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after 15 the date of the enactment of this Act.
