## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on dichlorprop-p acid, dichlorprop-p dimethylamine salt, and dichlorprop-p 2-ethylhexyl ester.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DICHLORPROP-P ACID, DICHLORPROP-P DI-**  
4                       **METHYLAMINE SALT, AND DICHLORPROP-P 2-**  
5                       **ETHYLHEXYL ESTER.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.25 of the Har-  
7       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
8       dichlorprop-p acid, dichlorprop-p dimethylamine salt, and  
9       dichlorprop-p 2-ethylhexyl ester) is amended by striking

1 the date in the effective period column and inserting “12/  
2 31/2011”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
4 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
